REQUESTS

to participate in the Global Art Programme Waiting for Expo 2015 Italy - the Country ("Programme") and declares that s/he meets the requirements to take part in the Programme as set out in the rules governing the Programme ("Regulations") hereby attached under **Exhibit 1** which s/he fully accepts to be bound by.

The following documents are attached to the application:

- Copy of passport;
- Curriculum vitae;
- Copy of the documents demonstrating past participation in art shows, workshops and/or residence programs in accredited spaces and the publication of his/her works on catalogues or art magazines;
- Description of the Project (as defined in the Regulations).

The undersigned declares that if s/he will be designed as the winning Artist (as defined in the Regulations) s/he will execute an agreement with Artegiovine Milano that will include the following obligations:

1. The Artist will take part in the residency exchange programme "Global Art Programme Waiting for Expo 2015" and shall relocate to Italy for three months (the "Period"). Artegiovine shall take care of the Artist's stay in Italy.
2. Artegiovine shall pay all the second-class travel costs for the return trip from the Country to Italy.

3. The Artist shall receive board and lodging paid by Artegirovane which shall also reimburse the Artist for all expenses by paying the latter the gross and all-inclusive amount of Euro 2,000.00.
4. The Artist shall dedicate his time to studying and working in the premises identified by Artegirovane. The Artist shall use local materials and local production resources, collaborate with the curators designated by Artegirovane and shall concentrate in particular on the following themes: (i) healthy and sufficient nutrition; (ii) eco-friendly energy and the environment; and (iii) geo-architecture.
5. The Artist shall (i) submit the definitive Project to the designated curators at least one month prior to the end of the Period (ii) incorporate the agreed changes and (iii) produce the final Project before the end of the Period, it being agreed that the relevant production costs shall be borne by Artegirovane and in any case shall not exceed Euro 6,000.00. As part of taking part in the programme, the Artist undertakes to transfer the ownership of that piece of work (the "**Work**") upon the payment of Euro 25.00 to the institution which the Region of Lombardia or Artegirovane shall indicate.
6. For at least one week during the Period, the Artist will work with groups of children on the theme "surprise"
7. Together with the curators designated by Artegirovane, the Artist shall select other locations in the country and organize travel. The second-class travel costs shall be borne by Artegirovane.
8. The Artist must comply: (i) with the regulations of the residency exchange programme, and (ii) the laws and customs of Italy.
9. The Artist must keep a diary during the Period without any restrictions in terms of its form or content (the "**Diary**"). The Diary may be published in the form chosen by Artegirovane and/or exhibited by Artegirovane during the Expo 2015 or on any other occasion.
10. Artegirovane may make reference to the Artist's participation in the "Global Art Programme Waiting for Expo 2015" in any publication or announcement.
11. On the basis of the above, the Artists confers Artegirovane all rights – including publication and reproduction rights – which it may hold in relation to any material, concept and/or piece of work relating to the Work and/or the Diary.
12. Any dispute arising out of or in any way connected with this agreement shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Milan.
